First Bancorp Announces Cash Dividend

Southern Pines, N.C. – The Board of Directors of First Bancorp (NASDAQ - FBNC), the parent company of First Bank, has declared a cash dividend on its common stock of \$0.10 per share payable on January 25, 2019 to shareholders of record as of December 31, 2018. The \$0.10 dividend rate is the same rate that was paid in the previous quarter and represents a 25% increase over the dividend rate of \$0.08 paid in the comparable period of 2018.

First Bancorp is a bank holding company headquartered in Southern Pines, North Carolina, with total assets of approximately \$5.7 billion. Its principal activity is the ownership and operation of First Bank, a state-chartered community bank that operates 102 branches in North Carolina and South Carolina. First Bank also operates a loan production office in Raleigh, North Carolina.
